## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **Do I still need to register for Mass?**

For Sunday Masses – YES.

You can do so by going to [Click here for the trybooking link](#) (if you are unable to do so online, please call the parish office).

For Weekday Masses, there is no need to register. However, you will still need to record your name, address and phone number when you arrive at the Church.

### **How many people can gather for Mass?**

Sacred Heart Church 80

Mary Immaculate Church 50

We will set up chairs outside at Mary Immaculate Church and Sacred Heart Church if necessary.

### **Can I give the sign of peace at Mass?**

YES, but unless you are family members from the same household, please give a **non-contact** sign of peace (e.g., a nod, a wave or a bow).

### **Can I receive the Blood of Christ from the chalice at Mass?**

**NO.** For now, the bishop has asked us to distribute Communion under the form of bread only. Keep in mind that when you receive Communion under either species (i.e. the host or the chalice), you receive the presence of Christ fully. Also, for the time being, please continue to receive the host in the hand (not on the tongue).

### **Is the parish office open?**

**YES.** The parish office has resumed normal opening hours, Monday – Friday 9.00am – 2.00pm.

### **Can I have my child baptised?**

**YES.** However, please contact the parish office for more information.

### **What about Confessions?**

The Sacrament of Penance (Confession/Reconciliation) is by appointment.

### **Can I receive the Sacrament of the Sick?**

We are not yet celebrating Anointing Masses (due to the problems with anointing multiple people and the need to continually wash hands). However, if you or someone you know is **seriously unwell**, please call the parish office.
