The Feast of the Assumption – 15 August 2020

The commemoration of the death of the Blessed Virgin Mary (the Dormition, or falling asleep, as it was known in the East) is known as the Assumption because of the tradition that her body did not decay but that she was raised up, body and soul, into heaven. This tradition was already present in the sixth century; by the beginning of the twentieth century it was widespread; and after consulting the views of bishops all over the world, the Pope formally and infallibly declared the doctrine of the Assumption to be part of the authentic and ancient doctrine of the universal Church.

During this *Time of Pandemic*, the Bishop has dispensed the obligation to attend Mass.

You might like to spend some time of prayer and reflection upon the Resurrection of Jesus and the role Mary has as his Mother.

Each Sunday (and each day) is a time where we can offer a prayer of gratitude for the Risen Christ lived and made present in our world today.

'go gently in the midst of the fog'

Good Morning from my home to yours, peace be with you (during the recent rain).

This morning it's quite an extraordinary morning here down at Emu Park, the fog has enveloped everything can't see more than 100 metres as you can see, as I pan the screen. Whatever we are experiencing may we go gently, may we recognise the hurt and the pain and the suffering, that within that there is growth, healing and life afterwards.
