

Hello, my name is Max Martin and I am a member of the Parish Leadership Team for Emu Park and Yeppoon. We work with the Parish Finance Committee and collaboratively with Fr Matthew, to efficiently organise and maintain our parishes. While Fr Matthew is on holidays, a number of us have been invited to provide a short reflection on the weekend's Gospel readings.

This weekend's reading is a very important text for Catholics from the Gospel of Matthew. Jesus asks Peter, '*Who do you say that I am?*' Peter replies, '*You are the Christ, the Son of the Living God.*' The interesting thing for me is Jesus asks who do you **say** that I am. Not who do you **think** I am. This implies that Peter is **not just** a believer but is articulating to others an amazing fact Jesus is *the long-awaited Messiah* and even more incredibly *the Son of God*. Peter has recognised that history is changed forever. The Christ is here. In recognition of this, Jesus then says, '*Peter, you are the rock on which I will build my Church.*' We know Peter does not turn out to be the most reliable of followers, denying Jesus three times. However, his inner strength eventually comes to the fore and he is a key leader of the early Christians during the dangerous years ahead. Famously being martyred in the Gardens of Nero.

The question for us this week is – Who do I truly believe Jesus to be? And do I have the courage to say this aloud? To live my Christian convictions? On a lighter note, a school story which relates to this Gospel reading and 'Who do you say I am?' An early years' teacher during a Religion lesson, was observing her children while they were drawing. As she walked past a child who was working diligently, she asked what she was drawing. The little girl replied, 'I'm drawing God.' The teacher paused and said, 'That's great. But did you know that no one really knows what God looks like.' The girl replied, 'They will in a minute.' Have a lovely week, everyone.
