

As we look to the year ahead we hope and pray that the healing of our world can take place. There have been many restrictions and changes that have had to happen to help keep our community safe and well during these past days. We look to ways where and how we can continue to share the Mission of Jesus in our community.

As we look to the future, the question was asked: *What could be the best and most inclusive time to gather to celebrate Sunday Eucharist? Thinking of: younger and older members of our community, our schools and the boarders, families, people working or who have sporting commitments.* After seeking the advice and talking with the Liturgy Group, the Sacramental Team, the Leadership Group and members of the School Communities, as well as many informal conversations there will now be an extra weekend Mass in the Parish:

**5.00pm Sunday at Sacred Heart Church**

*Starting on the 1st Sunday of Lent*

This will be a permanent time for Eucharist in the Parish. There will not be a Saturday night Vigil Mass. The Sunday 5.00pm will be an alternative evening Mass and hope to be a time where our Parish can gather and celebrate Eucharist into the future.

At the Sunday evening Mass, interest has also been shown for a **'youth group'** to begin and be connected to the Sunday evening gathering time, this may also lead to new interest and possibilities as time goes on.
