## PALM SUNDAY – 28 MARCH 2021

*Hello from my home to yours, Peace be with you.*

Each year before Easter at The Haven Retreat Centre, Emu Park, the priests of the Diocese with Bishop Michael, gather in prayer and reflection to prepare for this very sacred time as we enter into Holy Week, and this weekend of Palm Sunday. It's been a very sacred few days. We prepare also for our **re-commitment at the Chrism Mass** with the Religious and faithful of the Diocese. It's a very special time where we with the people of our Diocese, recommit ourselves to the journey, to this very special time of Holy Week and Easter and recommit to the Ministry which we share.

**Bishop Michael blesses the sacred oils** which are used Sacramentally for this coming year: the oil used for the **Anointing of the Sick**, the **Oil of Baptism**, and the **Oil of Chrism** used for confirmation and ordination. The time at The Haven was a very sacred time and especially in our community here, we've had not only the priests of the Diocese we had seminary student, Peter Doherty, and Deacon Ashwin Acharya, from our own community here on the Capricorn Coast.

The Chrism Oil which Bishop Michael blessed, will be used in the priestly ordination ceremony for Deacon Ashwin.

We continue to keep him in our prayers as he prepares for his ordination to the presbyterate.

During these couple of days we've also reflected with parishioners and community members, on the **Year of St Joseph** and what it means to be at service. The celebration of the Chrism Mass and this time of Holy Week are certainly very much about being at service to our people and our community.

God bless to you all and may we each in our own way recommit ourselves to this very sacred journey.
