Many local parishioners attended and below are some of their reflections:

We are all missionaries in all we do, live and say. This does not mean we are continually preaching and talking about 'Church' and 'Jesus' but rather we are giving a message in all we do.

Our mission is to ask how the message of Jesus Christ is, Lived, Taught, Worshipped.

- Our belief is alive - we need to speak it.

- The Word is present - we need to speak it.

- God is always inviting us - we need to share it. (JM)

Relationship with Jesus is fundamental to Mission.

We must meet people in the ordinary, loving and listening, knowing when to speak and when to keep silent.

How am I doing Mission now? (HM)

Evangelization is the responsibility of each one of us in the situation/ space we are in right now, based on God's commandment to love God and love our neighbour as He loves asking Holy Spirit to be our guide and strength

And heeding the quote from Book of Esther 4: 14 "... for just such a time as this. "

I might never get another chance to say or do what I'm inspired to do at this moment (MC)

The presenters of the sessions were very professional and empathetic. They had an important message to convey – that we are all missionaries of the Gospel through our baptism and that we, as church, can spread the good news by combining our faith with mission by the way we live our everyday lives. They conveyed the message very powerfully in words we could easily understand and translate into action simply through living the life given to us through God's love. (ML)



WELCOME PACKS - NEW PARISHIONERS

MINISTRY APPEAL

There are many fine ministries of service in this parish because they do their work so well, most of the time we don't notice them unless we are on the receiving end of their care or are involved. One of them is the ministry of Communion to the Elderly and Housebound in our parish. You see people coming up at the end of Mass receiving the Body of Christ to take to the homes. They go, with our blessing and representing us, the Church, the parish community of Sacred Heart. There is also another ministry and I have to be careful how I say this, but I think it is one of the jewels in the crown of this parish: it is the ministry of Communion to the aged Care Facilities. We have three, Sunset Ridge, Capricorn Gardens and Adventist Retirement Village. Each week these facilities are visited by two people in our ministry to pray with, give Communion and assure them that they are remembered and prayed for in our community. They pray for you.

By now, you know where this talk is going. For various reasons, some of our stalwarts can no longer go to the facilities. But each time, we need two people to go. Not just because of Safeguarding Regulations, but also because, as last Sunday Gospel told us, Jesus sent out the disciples two by two. We go representing you, the Church. If you are thinking, I can't possibly do something like that, pause and think again. We ask for two hours a month, on a Thursday or Friday. At Emu Park, it is on a Saturday? It is rostered and you know months ahead when you are needed. The service is well organised already. Denis Murphy has put together a marvellous power point program, including the words, beautiful pictures AND hymns, most of which are sung by Tink Boyd and her choir. Even then, if you think, I can't stand up and do that, we just as importantly need someone else there, even if you say nothing during the service. And if you think I can't do that, we need people who can just run the computer moving the power point along.

This is not an overwhelming ministry, but it is a fulfilling one. Each time we go, we see people, who may be confused, who may suffer dementia, who surprise and inspire us by their desire for Communion with their Lord Jesus the one whom they have loved and served through their lives. Thank you. Sr Kym Harris
