







THE HOUR OF GREAT MERCY:
 (Three o'clock in the afternoon)

“At three o'clock, implore My Mercy, especially for sinners: and if only for a brief moment, immerse yourself in My Passion, particularly in My abandonment at the moment of agony. This is the hour of great mercy for the whole world. In this hour, I will refuse nothing to the soul that makes a request of Me in virtue of My Passion...” (Diary 1320) *“You can obtain everything for yourself and for others for the asking; it is the hour of grace for the whole world – mercy triumphed over justice.”* (Diary 1572)

Jesus laid down three conditions necessary for prayers which shall be offered up at the hour of mercy in order for them to be heard and answered:

**The prayer is to be directed to Him.
 It is to take place at 3pm, and it is to appeal to the merits of His Passion.
 It is to be a prayer full of trust and accompanied by works of mercy towards one's neighbour.**
